Buster was born in Florence, South Carolina and attended The Citadel on a baseball scholarship. While at The Citadel, he was an All-American Catcher and Southern Conference Batting Chairman, 1969. After graduation, Buster attended The University of South Carolina School of Law where he was a member of the South Carolina Law Review. He earned his Juris Doctor Degree in 1972 and was admitted to practice with The South Carolina Bar at that time.
