Professional Experience: Joel B. Rosen is a partner with Montgomery McCracken and concentrates his practice in alternative dispute resolution, as well as white collar criminal defense, internal investigations and commercial litigation matters.

Serving as a United States magistrate judge from 1987 to 2006, Mr. Rosen has mediated thousands of cases, presided over numerous civil jury and bench trials and criminal misdemeanor trials. He has negotiated multi-million dollar settlements and resolved all manner of complex cases and class actions in the areas of employment law, commercial law, environmental law, intellectual property, anti-trust, admiralty, civil rights, construction law, and torts.

Mr. Rosen has a broad knowledge of criminal process and procedure in both the federal and state venues. He served as an assistant United States attorney and was the attorney-in-charge of the United States Attorney's Office in Camden, New Jersey. During his tenure, he received several commendations from the Department of Justice for his efforts in connection with prosecutions involving organized crime and political corruption. He is also a former deputy attorney general in the New Jersey Division of Criminal Justice where he was chief of the Special Prosecutions Section. He served as a law clerk to the Honorable Mitchell H. Cohen, United States District Court, District of New Jersey.

Professional Activities: Mr. Rosen is a member of the Lawyers Advisory Committee of the United States District Court, District of New Jersey. He was an adjunct faculty member of Rutgers School of Law, Camden, where he has taught class actions and complex litigation. He has also taught constitutional principles at Rutgers University, Camden and has lectured at numerous continuing legal education programs. Mr. Rosen is a member of the Disciplinary Oversight Committee and the Committee on Minority Concerns of the New Jersey Supreme Court. He is a member of the Board of the Association of the Federal Bar of New Jersey. He served as the chair of the U.S. Magistrate Judge Selection Panel for the U.S. District Court, Camden vicinage.

Honors and Awards: Mr. Rosen served as president of the Federal Magistrate Judges Association. He is the recipient of many distinguished service awards, including the *Hon. Joseph M.
