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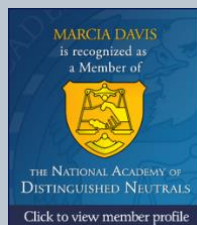

FEE SCHEDULE

Mediation fees are maintained online to ensure the most current information is always available. Please visit mdavismediation.com/#fees for current rates.

THE FOLLOWING MINIMUM FEES APPLY

- Minimum of three (3) hours for half-day mediation
 - Minimum of SIX (6) hours for full-day mediation
- Fees will be divided equally among the parties unless otherwise agreed.

CANCELLATION POLICY

To avoid the minimum fee, cancellations or rescheduling requests must be made in writing no later than 5:00 PM EST, eight days prior to the mediation date. Cancellations or rescheduling requests received after this time will result in the minimum fee being charged, and all parties will be billed equally.

TRAVEL CHARGES

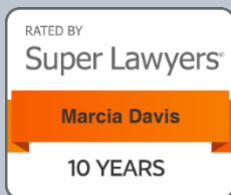
There is no charge for travel time to mediations held in Marion, Alachua, Columbia, Levy, Putnam, or Suwannee counties. For other locations, travel time is billed at half the standard hourly rate unless other arrangements are made in advance.
