While a lawyer, Judge Zemetis tried several hundred cases in the State and Federal Courts of Connecticut, the Connecticut Workers Compensation Commission and other administrative agencies, state and federal, within the State of Connecticut. He successfully handled appeals in the Second Circuit Court of Appeal, the Connecticut Supreme Court, and the Connecticut Appellate Court.

Judge Zemetis, as a lawyer and later as a judge, participated in over 2800 arbitration or mediation proceedings resolving disputes involving: aviation, construction, contract, employment, insurance, personal injury, professional negligence and products liability. He was actively involved in the Connecticut Judicial ADR program.

During his years as a Connecticut Superior Court Judge, he handled civil and criminal court dockets. He presided over both criminal and civil jury cases, court trials, special proceedings cases and the foreclosure and housing dockets. During his last four years on the bench he managed the Connecticut Complex Civil Litigation Docket in Waterbury Connecticut presiding over aviation, business disputes, construction, employment, insurance, negligence, products liability including medical devices, and professional negligence.
